



TOGAF™ 8 to TOGAF 9™ Bridging - eLearning

Course objective and pre-requisites

The objectives of the training course are:

- To ensure detailed understanding of TOGAF version 9 from a Practitioner's viewpoint
- To ensure understanding of the changes between TOGAF 8 and TOGAF 9
- To prepare TOGAF 8 Certified practitioners to be able to take the TOGAF 8 to 9 Advanced Bridge examination to achieve TOGAF 9 Certification (Level 2)

The Architecting the Enterprise eLearning programme provides detailed training in TOGAF for those seeking to use TOGAF in their own enterprise and/or those seeking TOGAF certification and is built around the core TOGAF Architecture Development Method.

Students should already have an understanding of IT or Enterprise Architectures. Students should also have a high standard of written English. Students must already hold or have held a TOGAF8 Certification in the past.

Mentoring approach ensures success

We employ a mentoring approach to eLearning, supporting the student through the self-study material. Mentoring consists of email discussions with a personal mentor and webinars conducted by one of our principal mentors. The mentor works with the student, assessing progress via a workbook. The instructor's final assessment of the completed workbook leads to successful students being nominated for the Architecting the Enterprise TOGAF version 9 Gold Award. After completing the course content and the workbook (providing they are TOGAF 8 certified or have been in the past), students will be in a position to take the TOGAF 8 to TOGAF version 9 Bridge examination to achieve full TOGAF version 9 Certification.

Course duration

The student typically completes the course on a part-time basis over six to ten weeks. Successful completion of the course normally takes at least 20 hours of self-study and requires the satisfactory completion of a workbook, comprising 30 short factual questions and 8 multiple choice scenario based questions.



Webinars

Two-hour webinars are available twice a month to help students with the eLearning materials. Delegates can attend up to 3 webinars in the duration of the course.

Course content

The course will cover the new features introduced in TOGAF version 9 below and summarise the underlying framework of TOGAF carried forward from TOGAF 8:

- Architecture Partitioning
- Content Framework and Meta Model
- Capability Based Planning
- Business Transformation Readiness
- Using TOGAF to develop Security Architectures
- Architecture Repository
- Using TOGAF to develop SOAs
- Stakeholder Management
- Gap Analysis derived from Gap Analysis with new materials
- Business Transformation Readiness

This course addresses ALL of the Learning Outcomes required for TOGAF Version 9 Level 1 and Level 2.

On Completion of this Course

Individuals who successfully complete this course will understand the new features added in TOGAF version 9 and the core concepts of TOGAF.

They will be able to:

- Critically evaluate the features of TOGAF version 9 to determine applicability within an enterprise that has already adopted TOGAF version 8
- Plan the introduction of TOGAF (version 8 or 9 or a combination of the two versions) into an enterprise
- Undertake the advanced bridge examination required to achieve TOGAF version 9 CERTIFICATION (Level 2)

Candidates who successfully complete the course and workbook will receive a Gold Award from Architecting the Enterprise.



TOGAF version 9 Certification Exams

TOGAF version 9 certification is based upon examinations provided by The Open Group through either:

- A Prometric testing centre
- An Architecting the Enterprise Examination Centre

On successful completion of the course, candidates will be able to take the advanced bridge examination that leads to TOGAF version 9 certification. This is a supervised open book examination which includes:

- Transition from TOGAF 8 to TOGAF version 9 examination
- TOGAF version 9 Level 2 examination

This course does not address candidates who have not been TOGAF 8 Certified.

Alternative approaches to certification

As an alternative approach to learning TOGAF and working towards TOGAF certification, you should also consider instructor-led training courses held at various venues around the world.
